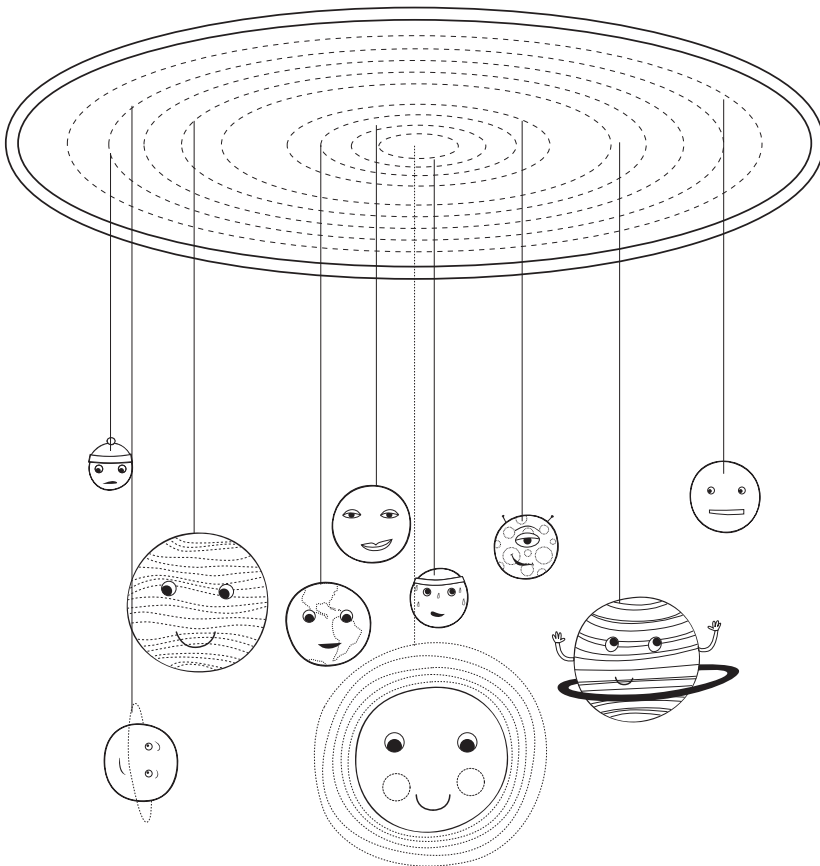
To make this mobile, you will need:

scissors
string
tape
markers or crayons
a dinner sized paper plate
something to punch holes
in paper plate and planets

1. Print out planets
2. Color and cut
3. Punch holes at top of planets
4. Print two orbit diagrams, cut and tape together to make a circle - use diagram to punch holes in the paper plate
5. Tie a string from each planet to the corresponding hole in the paper plate
6. Tape the end of the string to secure it to the top of plate

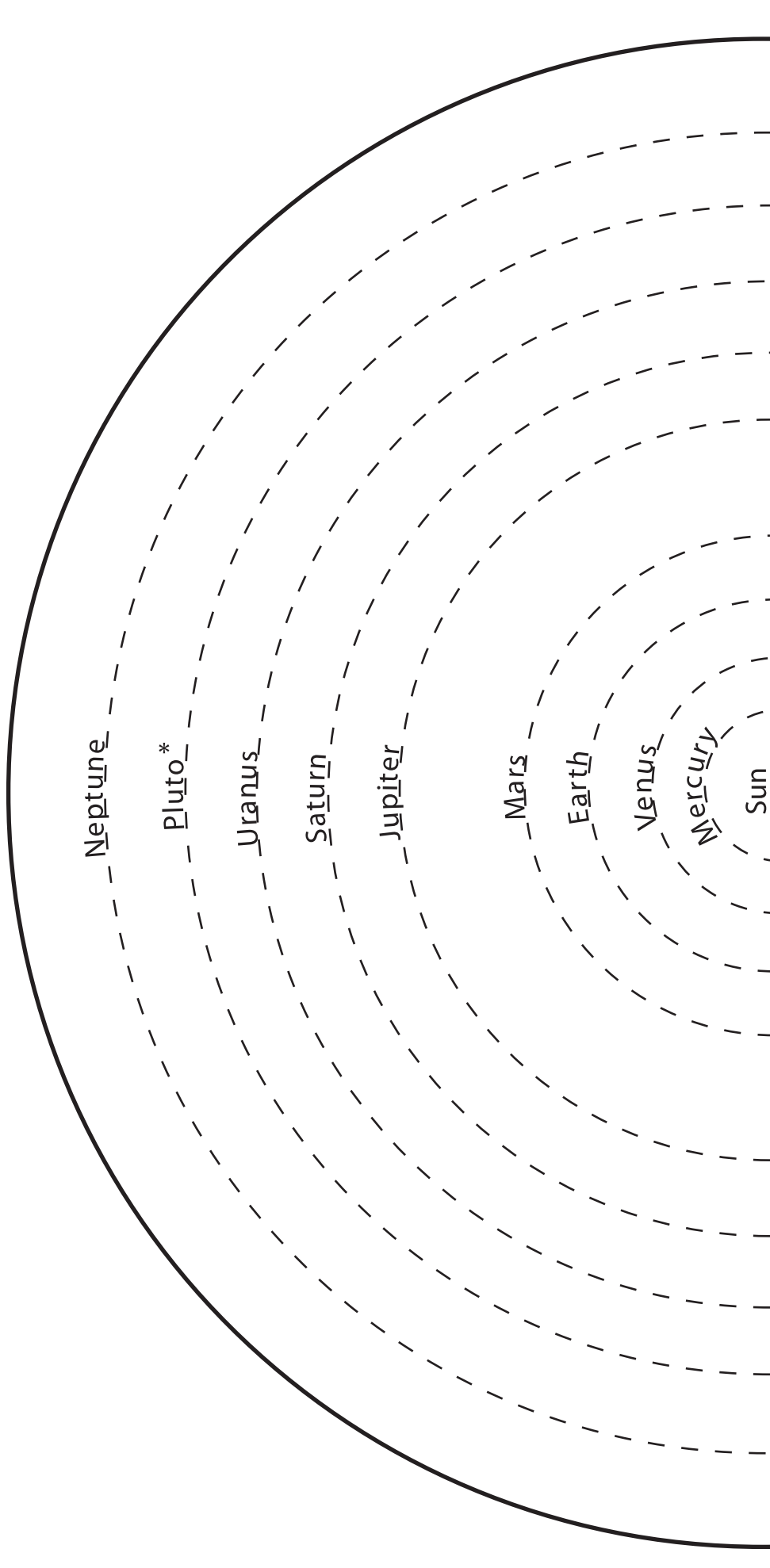
For Extra Pizzazz
